Today, a 14-year-old former pupil was sentenced following her conviction for the attempted murder of two teachers and a fellow pupil. This marks the end of the legal proceedings surrounding this tragic event.

The incident, which took place on April 24, 2024, caused significant harm to our school community. Two of our teachers, Mrs. Fiona Elias and Mrs. Liz Hopkin, along with a pupil, sustained serious injuries. While they have shown remarkable strength in their recovery, the emotional impact of this event continues to be felt by all those affected.

We are committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of our students and staff. We regularly review all procedures to provide a secure environment for everyone at Ysgol Dyffryn Aman. Support remains available for any students or staff who require it.

I would like to express my gratitude to the emergency services, Carmarthenshire County Council, and our local community for their support during this challenging time. Together, we will continue to foster a safe and nurturing environment for our students.
