

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you all well and that you have all enjoyed a relaxing Easter with friends and families. It is hard to believe that we have entered the last term of the academic year with only 11 school weeks left until the summer holiday. This term marks a milestone for pupils in Y11 and Y13, some of whom will be saying their final goodbyes to Dyffryn Aman in July.

Summer Examinations

This will be a busy term for pupils and staff as we make final preparations for the summer examination series. Pupils should have all received their examination timetables and be aware of when they will be assessed in each subject. As in previous years, the timings of the school day will change on Tuesday 6th May where lunchtime will start 1-hour earlier to accommodate afternoon GCSE and A-Level examinations. These timings will remain for the duration of the summer examination series.

Year 11

Y11 pupils are expected to attend school as usual until 23rd May. Attendance in lessons is essential to ensure pupils are fully prepared for each examination. However, once GCSE examinations start on May 8th, if you feel that it is in the best interest of your child's wellbeing to prepare from home and only attend their examinations, we will require written consent from yourselves as parents and guardians. A consent form will follow via email to all parents/guardians of Y11 pupils.

Pupils leaving the school site without parental consent and communication with the school will trigger our internal truancy processes.

Following the Whitsun half term, school will start on June 2nd and year 11 pupils are not to attend school other than for their timetabled examinations. All pupils are to wear school uniform when attending examinations.

6th Form

Y12 students commence their study leave from Thursday 8th May and will be expected to return to school after half term on Monday 2nd June.

From 9th May onwards, Y13 students will only be expected to attend timetabled lessons. Students are not to attend school, other than for their examinations, from June 2nd.

All sixth form students should be wearing full school uniform when attending school for lessons or examinations.

Summer Uniform Expectations

As we look forward to warmer weather during the final term, I'd like to remind you of the updates to our school uniform, introduced after consultation with parents last year. To help ease the cost of living and continue our efforts to poverty-proof the school, tailored shorts or black school PE shorts are permitted as part of the uniform. However, skin-tight athletic shorts are not allowed, and I would appreciate your support in reinforcing this with all pupils.

Students are still expected to wear ties with their short or long-sleeved shirts alongside trousers, skirts, or the approved shorts mentioned above. If a pupil arrives in incorrect uniform, they will be provided with suitable alternatives from our school uniform shop for the day, and parents or guardians will be contacted.
